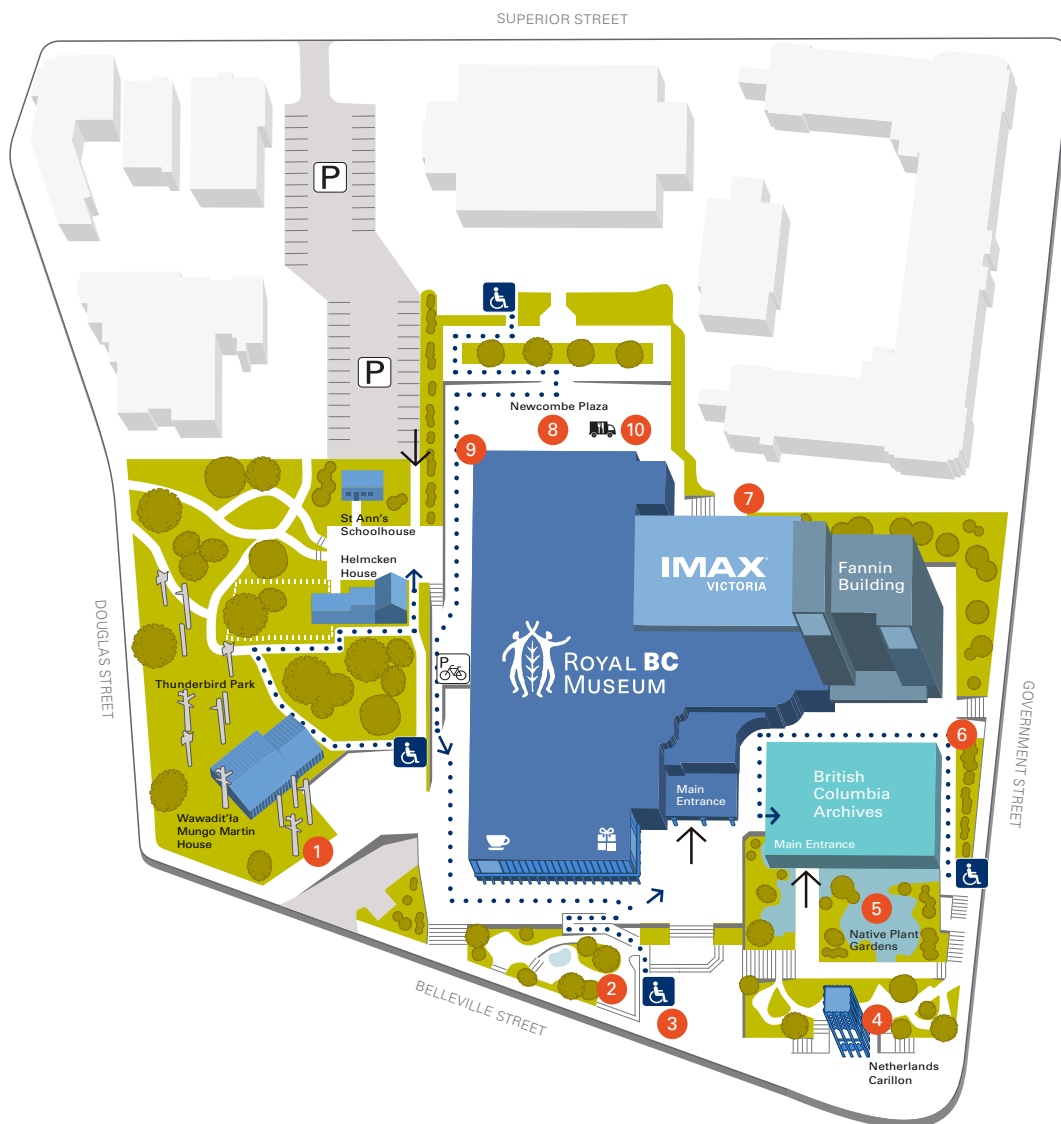

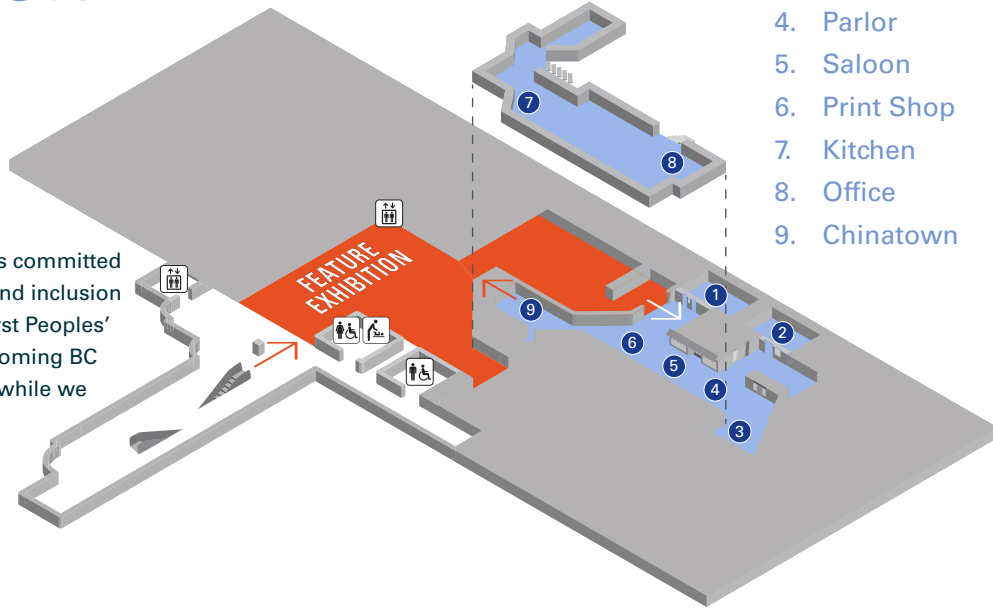

Old Town, New Approach

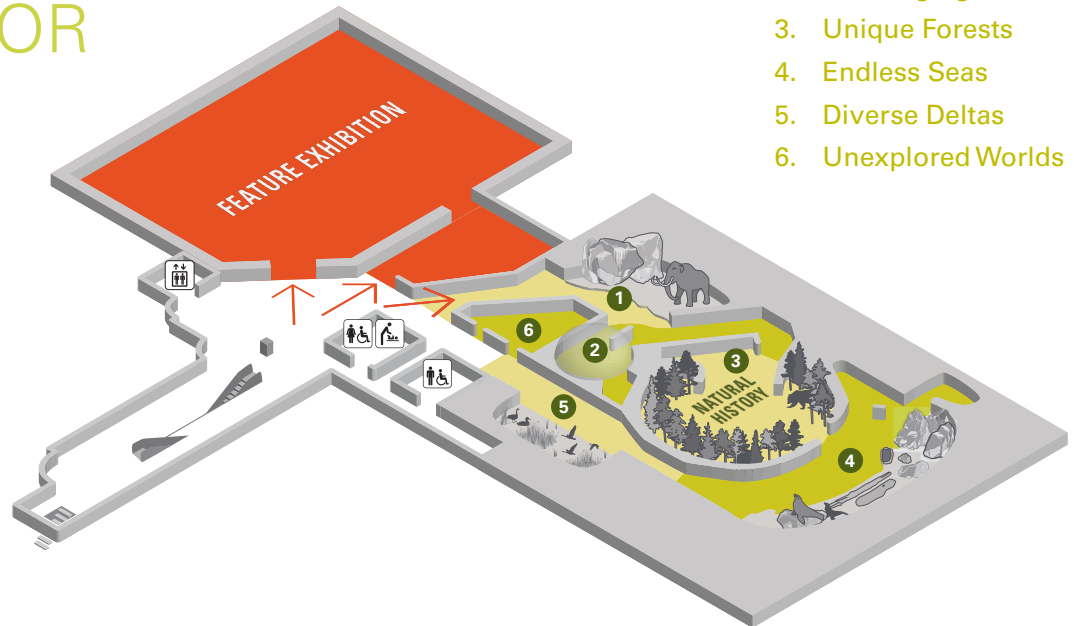
